As part of their ongoing efforts to reduce waste and prevent litter, **UK Recycling** is partnering with UK Dining to cover the one-time \$5 fee associated with the reusable to go containers for hundreds of students and staff. The Student Sustainability Council will vote tonight on a proposal to join the partnership, and if they approve, the three groups will join forces to distribute 1500 of the green to-go containers this fall. UK Dining is serving all meals in to-go containers this semester due to the pandemic. The complimentary containers will be available in the coming weeks at the entrances to Champions and the Fresh Food Company during meal times.
