Facilities Management’s **Planning Design and Construction (PDC) group** oversees all construction and renovation projects on the academic campus that have a budget of \$1 million or less. The team is led by **Tim Armstrong** and includes architects, engineers, and project managers. Depending on the size and scope of a project, the team may also work with contract partners. PDC project manager **Mark Wiggam** led a recently completed addition to the Environmental Quality Management Center near Cooper Drive. PDC’s **Brad Leach**, **Chris Seals** and **Eddie Robinson** led the in-house design for the project. The 900+ square foot addition includes a new entry, four new office spaces, and a student work area all within a unique space created by the rounded exterior wall. The building is home to UK’s Environmental Quality Management group which oversees compliance with water and air quality regulations and hazardous material management. EQM Director Bob Kjelland said, “The new addition is fantastic and the whole PDC group were great - from design to construction. They helped us attain our goal of adding more work space all within an existing paved surface yielding not only the unique shape but also reduced environmental impact.”
