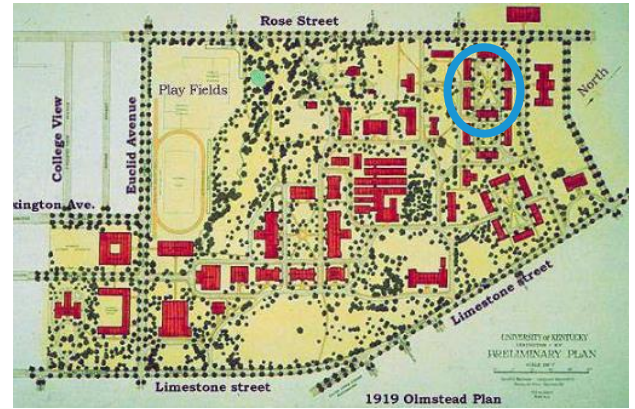

Wayback Wednesday – The Old Quad and the 1919 Olmstead Plan. In 1919, the planning firm founded by Frederick Law Olmstead – the famed landscape architect who designed New York City’s Central Park, completed a master plan for the University of Kentucky’s campus. UK’s historic quad of Bradley, Breckinridge, Kinkead,



Bowman Halls (left and circled at right) is one of the most prominent remaining vestiges of that plan. These four buildings were originally constructed as residence halls and now serve as offices for several programs. Bradley, constructed in 1921 is the oldest of the four followed by Kinkead (1929, Breckinridge (1930), and Bowman (1949).

COLD



Common Symptoms

Runny nose, sinus congestion, mild cough caused by postnasal drip.

Uncommon Symptoms

Fever, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing.

Onset

Gradual, within 1-3 days of exposure.

FLU



Common Symptoms

Fever, chills, muscle aches, and fatigue.

Uncommon Symptoms

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.

Onset

Sudden, within 2-4 days of exposure.

COVID-19



Common Symptoms

Fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell.

Uncommon Symptoms

Sneezing, runny nose, or sinus congestion.

Onset

Within 2-14 days of exposure.
