Did you know? Origin of our calendar



The 12 month calendar we use to mark solar years is based on a Roman calendar, revised in the first century BC by Julius Caesar. Caesar, on the advice of Sosigenes —an astronomer from Alexandria - added 90 days to the previous calendar and established the solar year as 365 days and six hours. The Romans established the concept of the leap year to accommodate the extra six hours and added a day to February, their shortest month, every four years.
