Free On-campus COVID-19 Testing Expanded to Include UK Employees.

The University of Kentucky announced Friday that it will begin offering free on-campus testing, beginning Monday, Aug. 10, to any UK campus employee who will be working on site this fall. Yesterday, employees with on-campus assignments should have received an email with instructions to schedule a test time and select a location, using their UKID. After scheduling, employees will receive a follow-up communication with instructions to register. Testing is available from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., seven days a week. Employee testing at these locations will be free, regardless of health insurance.

Daily COVID-19 Screening Required for UK Community

As the University of Kentucky prepares to make it easy to be safe this fall, all members of the community are asked to remember a simple idea: **Protect. Respect. Do your part.** As part of those efforts, all students and **employees** who come on to campus will be required to complete a COVID-19 screening, every day, seven days a week. Completion of this screening is necessary to remain in compliance with university policy. **Individuals will be required to begin completing the screening on the first day of classes, Aug. 17.** The daily screener is quick and easy.
