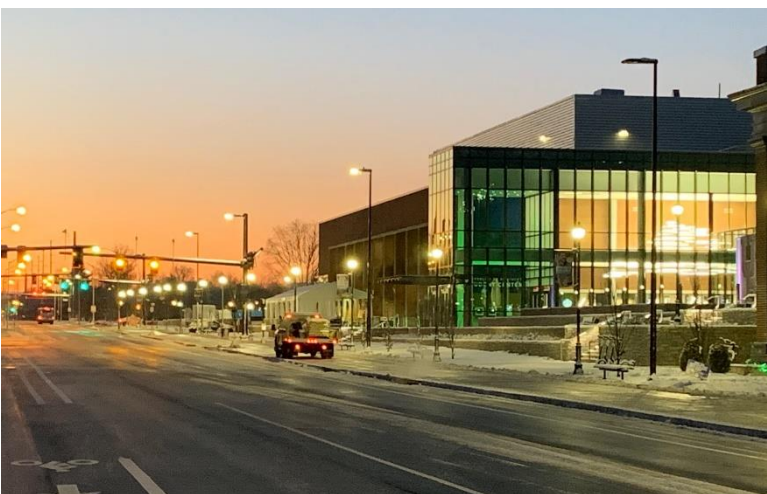


Photo Friday – Welcome Back Students!
