



# Vaccination appointment available soon to ALL UK Employees

UK President Eli Capilouto announced yesterday that all campus employees will soon be eligible to receive the Covid-19 vaccine at the Kroger Field clinic. The announcement also indicated that this new phase in community vaccination efforts would also include anyone classified as 1C on the vaccination priority schedule which covers anyone over 60, all essential workers, as well as high risk individuals over the age of 16. If you have not already registered to receive the vaccine, go to **ukvaccine.org** to request an appointment. The UK HealthCare clinic at Kroger Field is vaccinating more than 2000 people per day thanks to the dedication and volunteer efforts of hundreds of health care professionals and community members who are staffing the clinic.



UK Transportation Services is developing a new Bicycle Master Plan and is seeking campus input on their efforts to date. Facilities Management employees Warren Denny (University Architect) and Shane Tedder (Sustainability Officer) are both working directly with Transportation Services on the new plan, and many of our teams are involved in supporting UK's transportation infrastructure on a regular basis including helping install bicycle parking and keep bicycle lanes and roadways free of debris and snow. UK was recognized in 2018 as a Gold Level Bicycle Friendly University and wants to use the new Bicycle Master Plan as a roadmap to platinum status. ### DON'T FORGET YOUR DAILY SCREENINGS

Employees who come to campus for their work assignments are required to complete a COVID-19 screening, every day, seven days a week, regardless of how many days per week they come to campus. The daily screener is quick, easy, and takes less than 3-5 seconds if you don't have symptoms.

Any employee with an on-campus work assignment will receive a daily email with instructions for completing the screening. If you do not have regular access to email, your supervisor will provide a paper copy of the screen.
