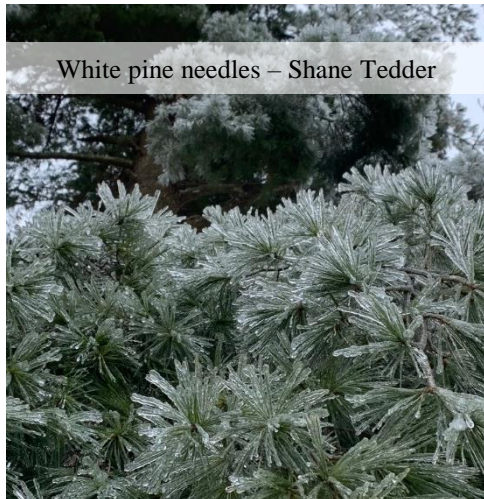


Photo Friday – Ice Storm 2021

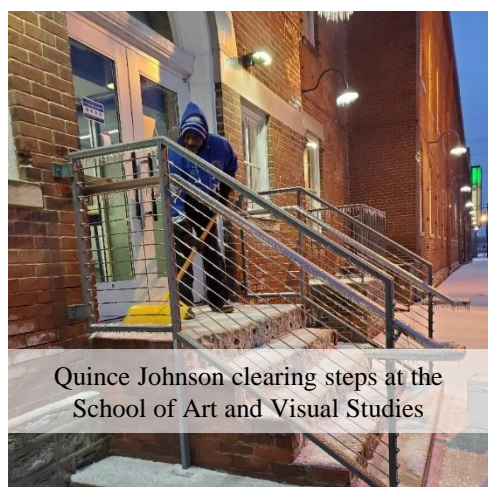

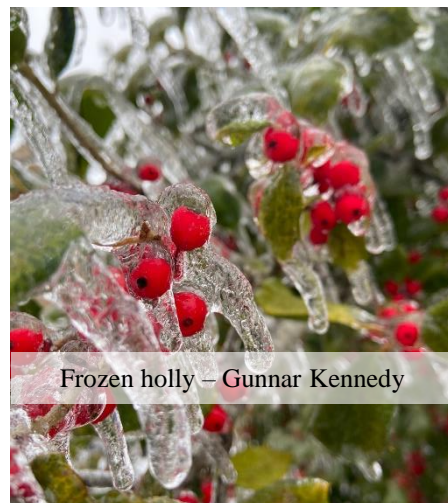
