Did You Know? A special series this week in honor of the 51st Earth Day (April 22, 2021)

A special series this week in honor

Did you know that UK Facilities Management's Capital Projects team has managed the construction of more than 25 buildings that have received LEED Certification from the US Green Building Council? LEED stands for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design and certification is awarded based on points earned for building design that prioritizes environmental stewardship and human health across a range of construction areas including energy and water use, material selection, and indoor air quality. UK's first LEED certified building was the Davis Marksbury Building which opened in 2010 and our most recently certified project was the Kentucky Proud Park (left) which received certification last summer. More than 15% of our indoor spaces have received this certification over the past decade.
