### Photo Friday – News Quiz Edition – Round 4

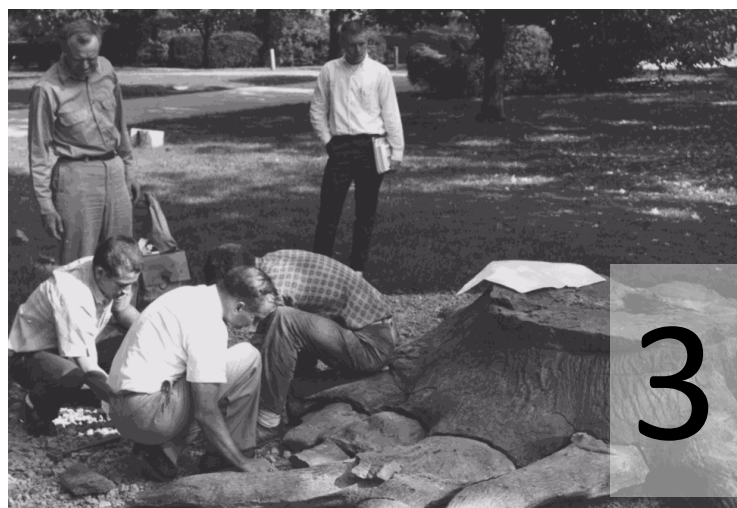
