SUMMER 2016 INTERNSHIP UK STUDENT SUSTAINABILITY COUNCIL

Position Description

- This is a summer position to serve the development and transition of the Student Sustainability Council from the 2015-16 to 2016-17 school year.
- The candidate should be able to work independently, synthesize information from multiple projects and reports, strong writing skills, and familiarity with Excel.
- Timing is flexible to the candidate's other summer responsibilities, with a tentative start of Tuesday May 10th, but should expect to put an equivalent of 12-14 hours per week for 12 weeks.
- \$10 per hour for up to 160 hours.

- Follow-up with 2015-16 projects.
- Table at various summer events on behalf of the SSC, and organize other SSC events.
