As the campus-life of many students is relatively short-lived, we would like to promote faculty/staff involvement in student-oriented sustainability projects, specifically those who have demonstrated exemplary service to mentor and inspire students on sustainability education in and outside of the classroom as well as demonstrate efforts to foster interdisciplinary collaboration among students. We propose doing this by giving an award (plaque) to the voted-on faculty/staff member in order to increase recognition of sustainability education on campus. Additionally, the awarded faculty/staff member will receive \$1500 in order to spend on students doing sustainability work (i.e. we are enabling faculty members to continue student-centric initiatives even after the first batch of students graduate). The faculty/staff members will be able to reapply to the same award (if continued by the council) after five years.

13. Describe the intended University of Kentucky audiences and potential number of people impacted including any potential diverse segments such as student or community organizations and supporting evidence (e.g. expected or historical event/speaker attendance).

The intended audience is sustainability-oriented faculty/staff members that actively engage students in on-campus sustainability projects or in-class conversations. The \$1500 from this award will be allocated to students' benefit as overseen by the awarded faculty/staff member. Examples of accepted expenditures with the award will include class trips (transportation, entrance fees, etc.), in-class demonstration materials or speakers, student salaries, ongoing campus sustainability with direct student involvement, and other expenses deemed acceptable by a sub-committee of the council.

Yes, the students will directly benefit by the \$1500. The exact benefit (i.e. skills or experiences) gained by the students as well as the number of students impacted will vary based on the faculty member awarded and their student sustainability-oriented goals.

Both project leaders have member SSC council members for several years and directors for at least one year each.
